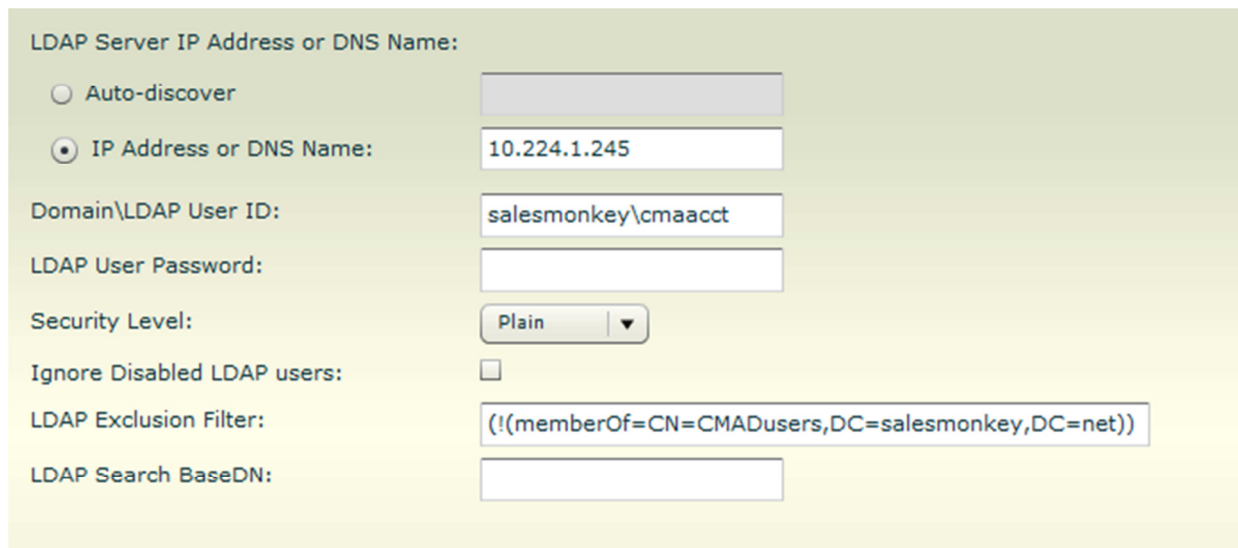
Version(s): All

Scenario: You want only members of a certain group to be able to access and use CMAD.

Problem: The way the UI is setup it asks for an Exclusion filter to block out users from CMA rather than to include them.

Solution: Just Inverse the filter to say Exclude anyone NOT in this group.

Set your inverse exclusion filter in CMA

LDAP Search BaseDN:

(!(memberOf=CN=CMADusers,DC=salesmonkey,DC=net)) simple means 'Anyone NOT in CMADusers group'

CMA already puts a NOT in front of this field to make it an exclusion . So this whole thing appends to any ldap search 'Search for anyone that is NOT , NOT in this Group...' " double negative makes a positive.
