



Windows 10 Reinstallation / clean installation

- You can/should **directly download Windows 10** ISO from Microsoft site or **download Media creation tool** from Microsoft site, create installation DVD or installation USB drive and proceed with clean installation/reinstallation

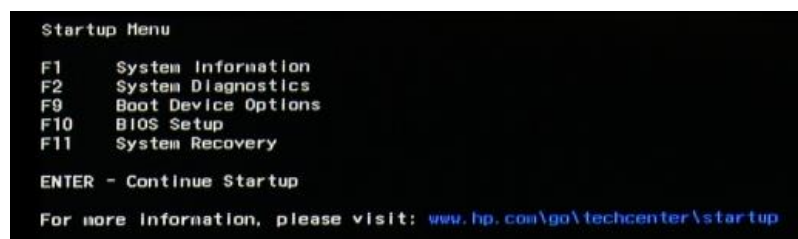
Make sure you select the proper version if asked (64 bit / Home or Pro)

Media Creation tool will always provide you with the latest Windows version/build (21H1 or newer...)

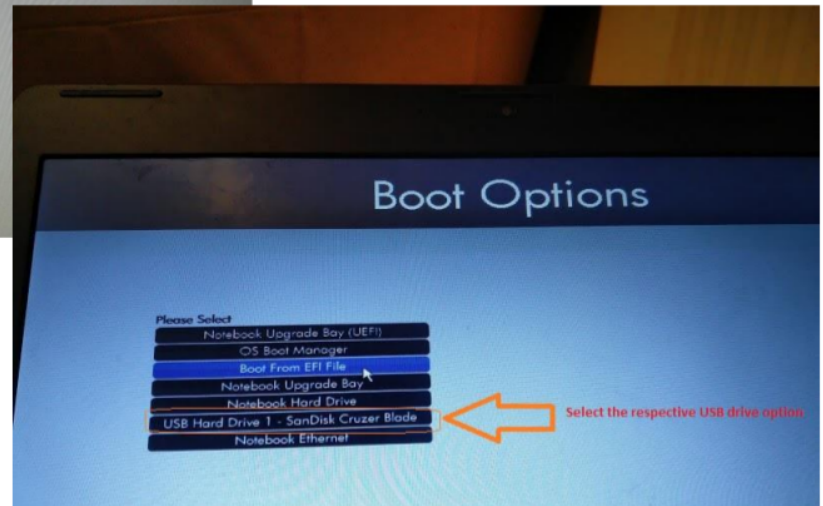
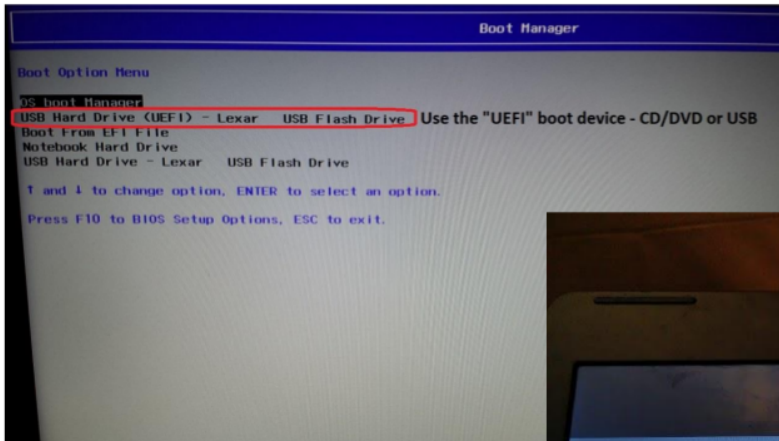
- When **download completes**, you will need to write the ISO image and boot from a bootable media.
Consider the USB pendrive option. You will need a blank USB pendrive (min 8 GB capacity). Follow the media creation tool instructions

- **When ready with the USB drive:**

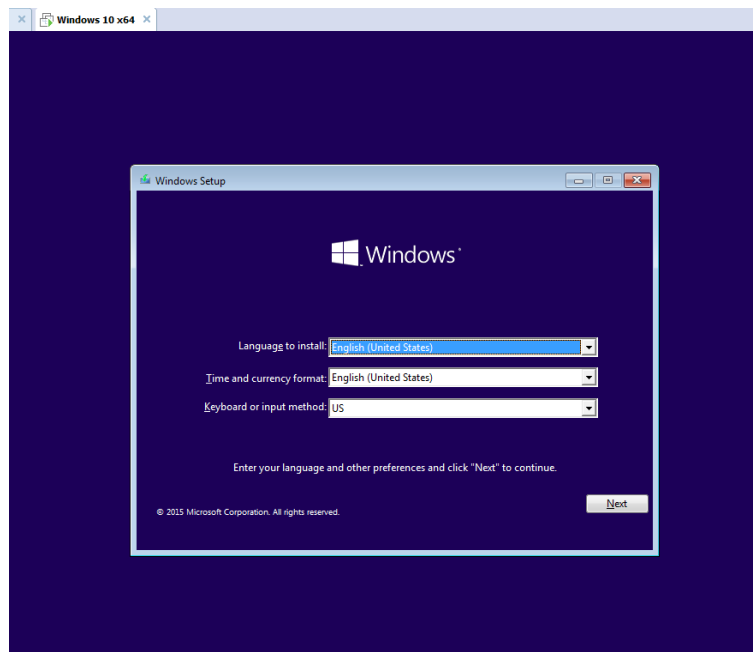
- Please, shutdown the computer using the power button.
- Insert the Windows USB thumb drive prepared previously
- Press the button to POWER ON the PC.
- As soon as you press the power-on button, immediately start hitting the **Esc** button repeatedly (like tap-tap-tap).
- This should open the HP Startup Menu similar to this one



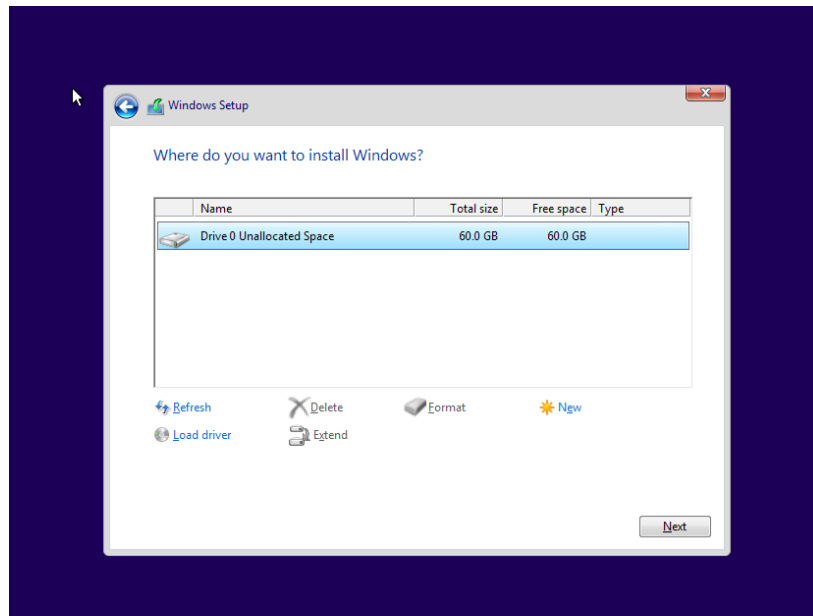
- Press/hit **F9** from your keyboard to open **Boot device options**.
- Select the USB thumb drive as a boot option and wait a while



- Follow the on-screen instructions to install Windows 10.



- Perform clean installation/custom installation (not repair) using the INSTALL NOW button.
- Delete all existing partitions and install Windows on *Disc 0 Unallocated space*



Windows 10 After successful installation

- Connect to a **Wi-Fi** or **cable/LAN** network only after you see your Desktop – not prior to it
- Click on Start → Settings → Update & Security

to **Update Windows** immediately - this will update Windows but it will also install drivers for this device to enable/active the hardware

Ensure you RESTART Windows several times to ensure all updates have been installed

- Make sure Windows is Activated by going to Start → Settings → Update & Security Windows Activation

- You may wish to stop some of the Windows Telemetry by using free tools such **DWS Lite 2.2.2.2-**
